#### • COLLABORATE

- Collaborate with 60 organizations in Australia and overseas 13 (22%) "industry partners" in grant.
- A total of 13 organizations appeared as "an industry partner" in grants proposals.
- Collaborate with over 270 collaborators in Australia and overseas.

#### • FUND

- Responsible for 73 competitive grants with an overall success rate is 45%.
- A total of 33 (\$3.0M) grants were awarded, 31 (\$2.7M) were successful.
- Amongst the senior investigators on 68 (93%) grants including 32 awarded ones representing \$2.7M.

#### • CONSULT

- Managed over 61 large-scale consultancy projects of research for 24 clients in 9 countries.

### ROLE AND ACHIEVEMENTS : SHARE KNOWLEDGE

#### • PUBLISH

- Responsible for 200 publications (5 books/monographs, 2 book chapters, 74 articles, 109 abstracts).
- First, second or last author of 80% (159) of these publications, including 51% (102) as a first author.

#### • PRESENT

- Presented at 117 events in 52 cities in 19 countries, including 69 as invited speaker.
- Presented in 65 conferences.

#### • LECTURE

- Lecture over 1,100 hours in 3 teaching and research intensive universities across 3 continents.
- Student satisfaction rate over 80% (Biomechanics, Adapted Physical Activities and Performance Analysis).

- Involved in supervision of 39 students (21 (51%) postgraduate) in Australia, Canada, Belgium and UK.

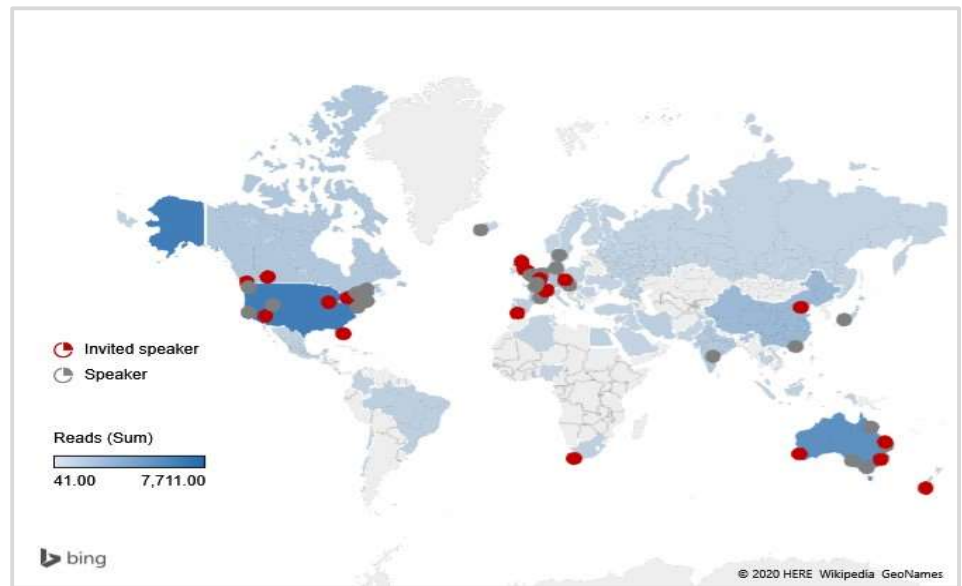
- Scopus H-index=18, citations=815, Google Scholar H-index=26, i10-index=52, citations=2,929.

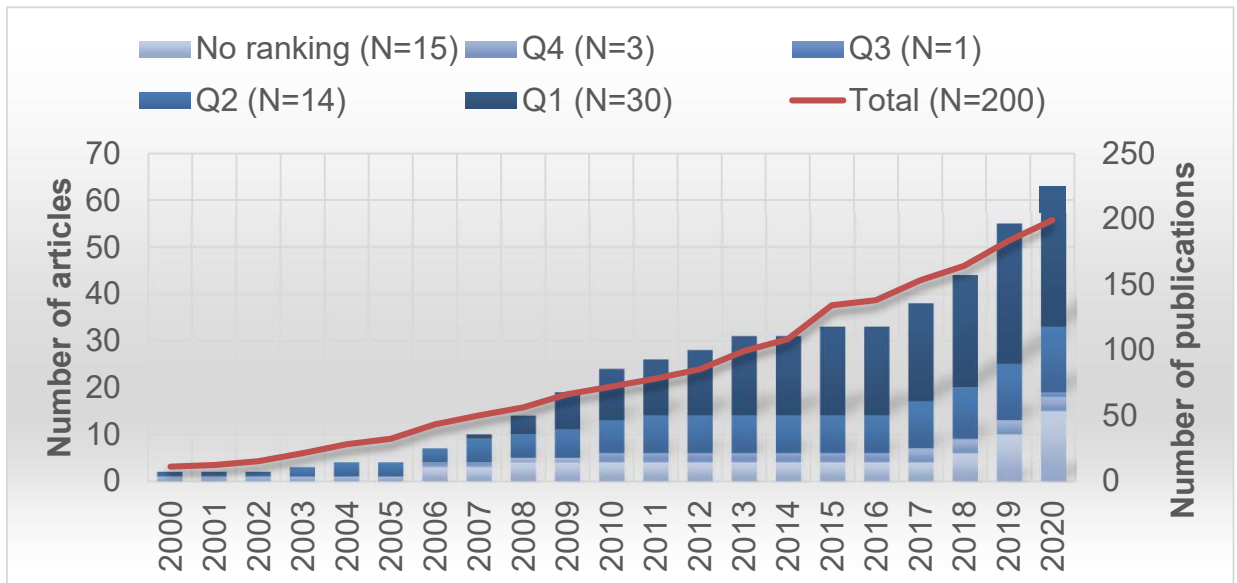
